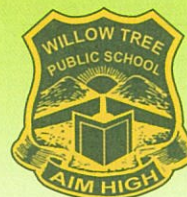

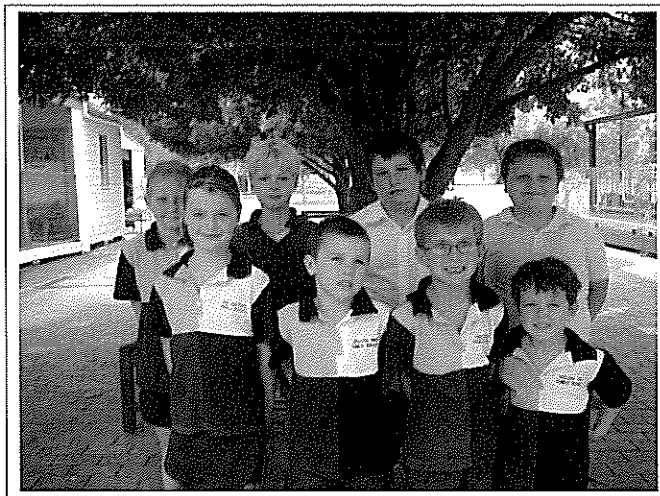

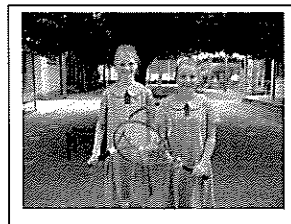


ZONE TENNIS TRIALS
